


Let's start with the basics for what you need to know when taking your dog boating:

Ingredients:

- 4 ounces sausage ham or bacon, cut in small pieces
- 1/4 onion diced
- 1/4 green pepper diced or little bit of a spicy pepper, minced
- 1 tomato diced
- 2 eggs lightly beaten
- 2 large tortillas or 4 small tortillas (corn or flour)
- 1/4 cup shredded cheese
- 1/4 cup salsa

How to Make:

- 1. Sauté the meat, onion, pepper and tomatoes over medium-high heat until the meat is done
- 2. Add the eggs and cook to your preferred doneness. At the same time, heat a dry skillet over high heat. When hot, heat the tortillas one at a time by placing them in the skillet for about 15 seconds per side.
- 3. Place a tortilla on a plate, add half the egg mix, half the cheese, a bit of salsa and roll.

Bloody Mary w/ Horseradish & Smoked Paprika

Ingredients:

- 6-8 oz. organic tomato juice (bottled is much better than canned)
- 1 tsp. organic lemon juice, 1 tsp. organic lime juice, 1 organic lime wedge
- 2 dashes of Worcestershire sauce (or Bragg's Liquid Aminos for a vegan version)
- 1 Tbsp. pickle juice (or pickled jalapeno juice for more "kick")
- 1/4 tsp. Dijon mustard
- 2 dashes bottled hot sauce of your choice
- 1 pinch sea salt, 1 pinch freshly ground organic black pepper or organic pink pepper
- 2 tsp. Cyprus flake salt
- 2 tsp. organic celery salt
- · 1 pinch organic smoked paprika
- 2 oz. vodka
- 10-20 drops organic fresh horseradish extract
- Celery stalk, green olives, or other garnishes of your choice (I like mine simple)

How to Make:

- 1. In a pitcher or quart jar, combine all tomato mixture ingredients and shake
- 2. On a flat dish, combine flake salt, celery salt, and smoked paprika.
- 3. Rub lime wedge around the rim of a chilled pint glass and dip rim in salt/paprika mixture.
- 4. Fill your glass halfway with ice and add tomato mixture
- 5. Add vodka and stir with a long-handled spoon & garnish as desired!
