Tips for Boating with Kids

Whether you're new to boating, new to kids, or you have a new crew of children coming onboard, knowing these 10 tips for boating with kids will surely come in handy. We had a slew of young boaters tell us what they needed to know – and what they needed us to know – before leaving the dock, and we made sure the important bases were covered.

- 1. Get me a comfortable life jacket that fits—those old blocky orange things are no fun at all.
- 2. Tell me the rules before we leave the dock. Make sure they know to keep both feet flat on the deck, not to lean over the rail, etc.
- 3. Help them stay safe from the sun. Putting on suntan lotion and drinking lots of water is a must!
- 4. Warn them about falling hatch covers. They pinch little toes and fingers, and are one of the most common causes of injuries for kids.
- 5. Keep them involved with running the boat. Kids like steering or holding lines, and even scrubbing the boat at the end of the day.
- 6. Be prepared for seasickness—some homeopathic remedies, like smelling peppermint, drinking ginger ale, wearing wrist bands, and going barefoot are things to try.

- 7. Bring a change of clothes. When a child gets wet, they get cold a lot faster than an adult. So they need extra dry clothing onboard.
- 8. Show them how to hail the Coast Guard on the radio. If anything happens to you, they need to know how to ask for help!
- 9. Show them how to use the GPS.
- 10. If you're boating in saltwater, bring along some vinegar in case they get stung by a jellyfish!

Zucchini Pizza Casserole

Ingredients

- 4 cups shredded unpeeled zucchini
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 large eggs
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 2 cups shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese, divided
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese, divided
- 1 pound ground beef
- 1/2 cup chopped onion
- 1 can (15 ounces) Italian tomato sauce
- 1 medium green or sweet red pepper, chopped



How to Make

- 1. Preheat oven to 400°. Place zucchini in colander; sprinkle with salt.
- 2. Let stand 10 minutes, then squeeze out moisture.
- 3. Combine zucchini with eggs, Parmesan and half of mozzarella and cheddar cheeses.
- 4. Press into a greased 13x9-in. or 3-qt. baking dish. Bake 20 minutes.
- 5. Meanwhile, in a large saucepan, cook beef and onion over medium heat, crumbling beef, until meat is no longer pink; drain.
- 6. Add tomato sauce; spoon over zucchini mixture. Add remaining cheeses, red pepper.
- 7. Bake until heated through, about 20 minutes longer.

Warm Black & Blueberry Sauce

Ingredients:

- 1 cup blueberries (fresh or frozen)
- 1 cup blackberries (fresh or frozen)
- 1/2 cup water
- 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice (about 2 lemons)
- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter
- 1/4 teaspoon vanilla extract

How to Make

- 1. In a medium saucepan, combine the berries, water, sugar and lemon juice.
- 2. Bring the mixture to a boil over medium heat, then reduce to medium-low.
- 3. Gently simmer the sauce, stirring frequently, until it thickens and reduces to about 1 cup.
- 4. Remove from the heat and add the butter and vanilla. Stir until the butter is melted.
- 5. Serve the warm sauce spooned over plain Greek yogurt, ice cream, biscuits, pancakes, waffles or a simple Angel Food or Pound cake.
